As it gets a little cooler (below 89° during the day) you can start applying 2-4-D Broadleaf killer to your lawns again. You can keep applying as long as the weeds are active.

I saw tulips and daffodils, etc. at the stores this week. Buy now for selection and store them in a cool dark place until mid-October, so you don't stimulate them into growing this year. That will allow the bulbs to have all of their energy to get through the winter when they are planted. Buy early, mid, and late bulbs for up to six weeks of color.


