



the barriers we have erected around the equipment we haven't gotten to yet.

Another concern has been the lake level. We have been working to establish a protocol for managing that level, and as we learn more about the process, we should get better. The recent rain has overwhelmed the outflow system, so we are working to bring that level down. Expect it to drop beyond what would be "normal," as we need to lower it to reduce pressure on the pool until the preparations for opening to pool are completed.

## Golf Greens Corner

We are currently working through all the challenges that Spring presents us. The golf course, in general, came out of winter in good shape. The weather has been cool with some good rain events. Green aerification has been postponed until we get the irrigation system under control. We have fixed numerous breaks and are working through a power problem on a string of irrigation controllers. Once we have checked out the system we will begin watering at night and be able to begin some cultural practices on



the greens. The golf course has been fertilized and the weed contractor will begin treating the first week of May. Staffing levels are adequate for the amount of equipment we have. Our focus through the spring will be keeping on top of mowing, improving the irrigation system, and improving course conditions.

## Cemetery Corner



### Junior Golf


