#### Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

\*The weather is getting warm, and it's been great to see our community getting outside. The changes that are happening will make our open spaces even more enjoyable. First, a quick update on the playground repairs. Woodland Park was

blocked off, but this proved ineffective. Due to the state of disrepair, we removed that set of equipment. A vendor is scheduled to install the set of equipment that was originally purchased for Oscarson Park, since the Board decided to use what was available. Savings from other capital projects' funding has allowed for that installation to begin. We are timing that installation to take advantage of funding that may become available from a possible grant award. There will be some preliminary site preparation, but the goal to start the project is early June.

- \*Four parks, Parkview, Sagers, Ponderosa, and Gateway, are scheduled to be brought up to almost new condition by a manufacturer we have contracted. That contractor will start as soon as parts are available, hopefully also in June.
- \*The remaining parks have either no issues or require minor repairs or equipment replacement. We have reallocated money to start work on those as time permits.
- \*These projects had to wait until funding was secured to move forward. We appreciate our staff helping us increase efficiency and save money to bring these projects to fruition.
- \*This is the season for testing the irrigation systems. All the systems are charged, and the staff is assessing each line to look for issues. There may be some problems with bad sprinklers or leaks. This is normal after a winter shutdown, particularly in the parks where sprinkler heads get damaged by use. We are working towards increasing system automation that will send alerts of leaks and issues, allowing us to correct problems faster. There are still some older, battery-operated systems that will experience issues. Please call the office or the after-hours hotline to let us know if there's an issue.

## LAKE-FRIENDLY LIVING: PROTECT THE LAKE AND WATERSHED

#### Minimize Runoff

Runoff carries excess nutrients and pollutants to the lake.

- Reduce cement: opt for stone paths or permeable pavers.
- Reduce lawn to only the area where lawn is used; plant more trees and shrubs.
- Irrigate during cool hours, only when and where needed. Opt for shorter, more frequent cycles.
- Keep yard waste out of lake and storm drains, mow higher, apply phosphorus-free fertilizer\* in fall (or skip it altogether), use pesticides sparingly and only as needed.
- Use vegetative buffer, rain barrels and rain gardens to capture runoff. Vegetative buffers also reduce erosion, support wildlife, provide privacy and save time and money in maintenance.
- Eliminate pollutants. Try to eliminate pollutants at their source.
- Don't flush drugs: dispose through the Health Dept. or trash.
- Maintain vehicles so as to not leak fluids.
- Conserve water in your home.
- Reduce household hazardous waste: e.g. recycle, compost, use biodegradable products, clean paint brushes in a sink.

\*Lawn care companies and hardware stores can recommend phos-free fertilizer.

Phosphorus is the middle NPK number, e.g. 22-0-15.

## Junior Golf Clinics & League at Stansbury Park Golf Course



We're excited to help young golfers develop their skills and have fun on the course! Here's what we have going on for juniors right now:

\*After School Drop-In Clinics: Every Wednesday at 4 pm, now through May 21, we're hosting an after school junior golf clinic. It's \$10 per kid, and there's no pre-registration required—just show up! All skill levels are welcome. Don't have clubs? No problem—we can provide some.

\*Summer Junior Clinics: Starting May 27, we'll kick off our summer junior clinics. Pre-registration is required for these classes. Each class is \$60 per student and runs three days in a row, one hour each day. Buy two weeks, get the third week free. All skill levels are welcome, and we'll cover full swing, chipping, pitching, and putting. Clubs are provided for those who need them. PGA professionals teach all clinics, and we keep a small group size of 8 students per teacher. \*Junior Golf League: Our junior league begins Monday, June 9, and meets every Monday at 8 am through August 4. The league is \$100 per kid. 



