Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

We are excited for another beautiful summer, and will continue to improve our community! Here is an update of the changes that are happening.

*Playgrounds: We closed three playgrounds and removed another based on an inspection in March. We repaired the playground at Village Park, and it is now open. Four parks, Parkview, Gateway, Sagers and Ponderosa, should be repaired sometime in June once the contractor receives the replacement parts.

*The equipment at Woodland Park was removed to prepare for installation. The crew will soon begin rerouting the sprinklers and laying the groundwork for installation of the new park equipment. The park redesign will allow for an all-abilities playground, the reinstallation of the original swing set, and still preserve the tree we originally planned to remove.

*To prevent further issues, we have established a maintenance program and budgeted for replacement parts and materials to consistently maintain the playgrounds.

*After a year off, we have seen a significant increase in vandalism, theft and damage, including some criminal activity, that has been referred to the Sheriff's Office. As a reminder, enforcement in Stansbury Park is the responsibility of the Tooele County Sheriff's Office and occasionally the Department of Wildlife Services. We stay in constant communication with them and they are doing their best, but they are overwhelmed and short staffed like everyone else.

*We received a grant for the bridge repair, so we will plan the start date for that project for next year. We also have a number of projects that have been awarded, so the community will be buzzing with activity this year as we begin the lengthy process of repairing and replacing neglected infrastructure. *While we have finally achieved the resources to properly maintain the park, there are over 400 acres plus the lake and all the recreation facilities. That means it will take some time for us to get around to fixing everything. We do appreciate your interest and try to respond to everyone's input, but please understand that we may be working on a higher priority problem so it may take a while to get to other issues that are submitted.

Above all, have fun this summer and stay safe!

Summer is here at the golf course! We have been very busy on weekends, but during the week is still a great time to play. Due to the amount of play we have been experiencing, we encourage those who come out to schedule tee times.

Junior Golf Clinics & League at Stansbury Park Golf Course



We're excited to help young golfers develop their skills and have fun on the course! Here's what we have going on for juniors right now:

*Summer Junior Clinics: Our first round of clinics started May 27. Pre-registration is required for these classes. Each class is \$60 per student and runs three days in a row, one hour each day. All skill levels are welcome, and we'll cover full swing, chipping, pitching, and putting. Clubs are provided for those who need them. PGA professionals teach all clinics, and we keep a small group size of 8 students per teacher. Please visit stansburypark.gov/golf-lessons/ to view the Summer Junior Clinic Schedule.

*Junior Golf League: Our junior league begins Monday, June 9, and meets every Monday at 8 am through August 4. The league is \$100 per kid. Players should be comfortable getting around the course on their own. It's best if each child has their own clubs, but we can also help provide equipment if needed.



Water Safety Tips (from Robbie Reed)


- *Be aware of your surroundings!

- *Action is not embarrassing, because the consequences of acting are small compared to those of not acting.








