Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

*We are in the middle of the summer season, and I hope everyone is having fun and staying safe. There are some safety issues that need to be addressed. The rise in high-speed vehicles like e-bikes and motorbikes racing through the lakefront areas could potentially harm bystanders, especially young children. We request that people do not ride through those areas, but if you must, please travel at five miles per hour for safety. This will hopefully reduce injuries and ensure that everyone can enjoy the lake.

*Golf carts are being reported more frequently for dangerous driving, not only in our areas but throughout Stansbury Park. The County Commissioners and the Sheriff have requested our input on the rules that should be established to enable enforcement to reduce the number of accidents or potential accidents. *We are excited to be nearing completion of some of the projects around the park and anticipate completing even more through the coming months. Some of the work has taken much longer than we originally projected, but we chose higher quality and better standards over speed to increase longevity, as well as lower future maintenance costs. As residents enjoy the new structures, landscaping, and features of the parks and lake, we ask that everyone be respectful and take care of our community assets. We want to enjoy them for a long time to come!

*Irrigation is an important part of caring for Stansbury Park. We are attempting to get the entire park on an automated control system called WeatherTrak. Last year, we had 20 locations, and this year, we added another 20 locations. These locations were in place but not active on the system. There are additional locations that have been inactive for several years, which will require some time to troubleshoot and bring back to full operational status. Once these are functioning, we will assess adding additional locations to standardize our irrigation system. The goal is to reduce operational costs and increase responsiveness to issues significantly.

***Finally, Stansbury Days is approaching fast, and the events are coming together for unique family fun! We still have some room left for volunteers, so sign up for your favorite event! Contact the office for more information about how you can help.**

- **Thank you to our crews in pink!** Please allow them to do their jobs so they can repair and maintain our public spaces.

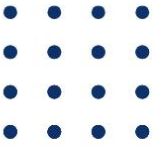

Duckling Rescues!

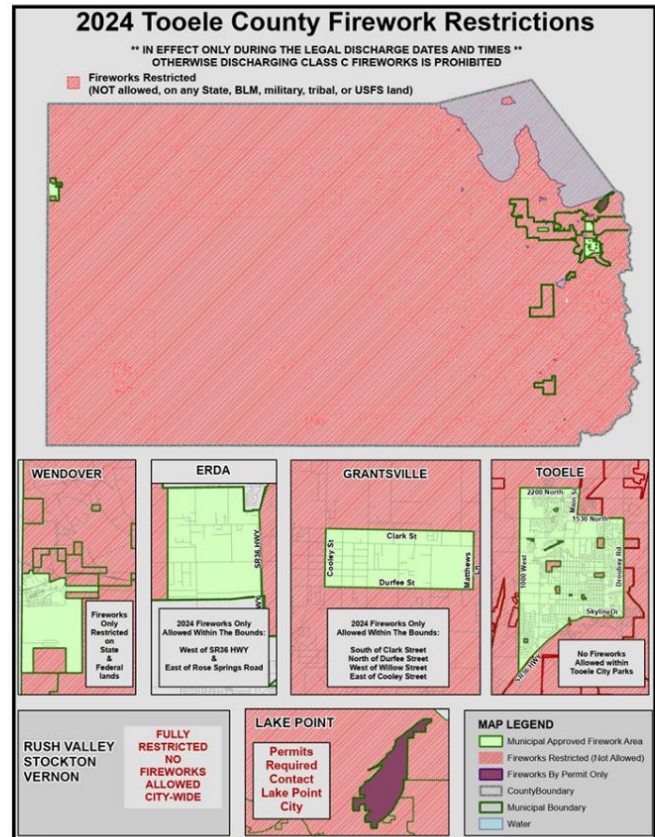

Junior Golf Clinics & League at Stansbury Park Golf Course

***Summer Junior Clinics:** Pre-registration is required for these classes. Each class is \$60 per student and runs three days in a row, one hour each day. All skill levels are welcome, and we'll cover full swing, chipping, pitching, and putting. Clubs are provided for those who need them. 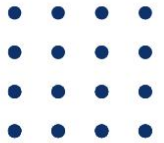

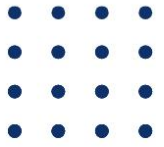
