## Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

Well, we've made it through the floods and the wild summer. The staff has completed winterizing the park and is now in fix-and-repair mode. You may see a lot of activity as we catch up on repairs and maintenance that are needed to prepare for next year.

A reminder to those around the lake that, starting this time of year, the lake level generally trends downward. We can pump from the Millpond once a week from April 15 through October 15th. We did forego the last two pumping cycles this year because the lake was still overfull from the storms. Gordon Well #1 is still pumping, so there is some inflow, but that will shut down when the weather gets really cold and the ponds start to freeze.

We have had some questions about water in basements around the golf course. We shut down Gordon Well #1, the main source of water feeding those ponds, during the weather event and for a week or so after, doing what we could to mitigate any impacts. The most likely source of water intrusion is groundwater. If you have those issues, check the grade and how well the foundation is sealed.

You may also have noticed many contractors around the park installing fiber-optic cables for internet service and updating the electrical system. We don't have much contact and little control over what they are doing. I talked to the county, and they indicated they didn't either. If you have a damage issue, I suggest contacting the company doing the work, or the county roads division if there are issues with the roads (we've had reports of potential damage there).

We have several winter events scheduled, including the Thankful 5K on November 15th, sponsored by the Stansbury Pageant Royalty. We will be conducting a food drive for the local food bank during that event. Please donate if you can. Our Christmas Market and Santa visit will be on December 6th. We are still open for vendor applications. And on the First of January, we will have the icebreaker plunge. This will be a USA 250 event, and you can check the county website for what that entails.

# PROJECT MANAGER UPDATE

- 4 Playground Fixes (Sagers, Ponderosa, Gateway, Parkview): After working on finding the right materials to update the safety of these four playgrounds over the summer, they have now been brought back to safety specification standards and are now open to the public.
- Clubhouse Dock: England Construction has been working diligently on bringing the Stansbury Clubhouse Dock to life. It is expected to be completed in early November, assuming the weather is kind, and structural safety has been assured.
- Woodland Park Playground: Woodland Park's new all-ability playground is complete! It is the first playground in Stansbury Park to feature full wheelchair accessibility throughout the play structure and surfacing.
- Millpond Park: The first phase of development includes the 20,000 sq. ft. parking lot and electrical connections for the restrooms, amphitheatre, and parking lot lights. This stage of development is expected to be completed at the beginning of December, assuming the weather is kind.
