Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

March marks the beginning of the meteorological spring, and that means preparations are in full swing to get ready for the summer activities. The Agency has made some significant upgrades to the infrastructure over the fall and winter. Because we had much less snow (well, none, really) and warmer temperatures, we were able to get a lot of work done on the irrigation systems. Porter Way Park has been added to Weather Trak, which will allow us to identify problems and correct them faster. Significant upgrades were done at Sagers Park and the greenbelt from Millpond Park to the clubhouse. One thing we are doing there is removing the larger, more expensive sprinkler heads and replacing them with our standard heads. The old heads are still used at the golf course, so they will not be wasted but will be put to good use there. Meanwhile, the replacement process will provide for a common, less expensive sprinkler on the park's side, which will help reduce cost and inventory requirements.

We are also moving into the start-up of sports leagues, so the team will be transitioning to preparations for both baseball and spring soccer. We continue to fight rodent damage on all fields, so the process of removing the pests and repairing the damage is ongoing. We will also repair the grass in areas damaged over the winter.

We are working on several projects around the pool to make the facility more usable and reduce costs. The rerouting of the backflush effluent is a major project that is required to improve our operations. We are also doing some repairs to the pool deck and replacing the lower pool valve. The pool manager and assistant have been hired and are setting up the summer schedule. We expect to start accepting swimming lesson requests in mid-March.

Hope everyone has a safe and enjoyable spring, and looks forward to the summer.

PROJECT MANAGER UPDATE

Sound Wall Trail:

The Agency has been working diligently with UDOT & Ensign engineering to finalize the contracting documents and designs needed to begin construction of the Sound Wall Trail. The development of this multi-phased non-motorized walking trail will begin in 2026 and will stretch from the corner of SR36 & Village Boulevard to Millpond Park. There is a contract in place for funding between UDOT & the Agency, under which UDOT will fund 80% of the build and the Agency will fund the other 20%.

Millpond Park Phase 1:

The final portion of this project is the installation of electrical equipment to power the restroom, food truck connections, and the amphitheater. The Agency has been working with Hughes General Contractors to complete this final portion of the project and anticipates completion by the end of March 2026.

Oscarson Park:

The Agency has been reviewing submissions from various architectural and engineering firms seeking to enter into a contract for the full design services for Oscarson Park. The submission window for firms to submit their qualifications is closed, and the Agency is still reviewing and discussing which firm will best meet the needs of this particular project. More information will be released as the board and committee continue to review the submissions.

Clubhouse Reflooring:

The Clubhouse has new flooring! In particular, the upstairs portion of the building, the Agency is excited to upgrade the aesthetic and functionality of the Clubhouse for all who use it.
