Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

As the weather begins to warm up, we're seeing more people—especially younger residents—out enjoying the parks. This is a great time to remind everyone about safety. One area of concern is the lakefront. Please remember that the boat ramp is an active boat launching area. While it may look like an inviting place to play, for your safety, we ask that you use other areas of the lakefront to access the water.

We also ask that no fishing take place around the dock or in the area between the dock and Pelican Point. We are working to maintain this as a designated swimming area, and lost fishing hooks can pose safety hazards to swimmers.

This year has been unusual for snowpack and winter water levels. As we bring irrigation systems back online throughout the park, we will not be watering on a regular schedule except in high-use areas such as the golf course and sports fields. Because much of the park's irrigation system is automated, we can selectively water areas that need attention while keeping the rest of the park on standby. We have also begun incorporating low- to no-water landscaping in areas where it will have minimal impact on park enjoyment. In addition, we are completing traditional spring maintenance, including fertilization and weed control.

We have received many questions about the park restrooms. Two key factors must be in place before they can open. First, since most restrooms are connected to the irrigation system, that system must be operational to provide water. In most years, this occurs between mid-March and early April. Although water may be available earlier this year, we still need cleaning staff in place before opening the facilities. These positions are filled by seasonal employees, many of whom are students still in school. Once we have hired or rehired enough seasonal staff, we will begin opening restrooms. This typically occurs between mid-April and early May.

In the meantime, please continue to enjoy the parks, and we will work to have the restrooms open as soon as possible.

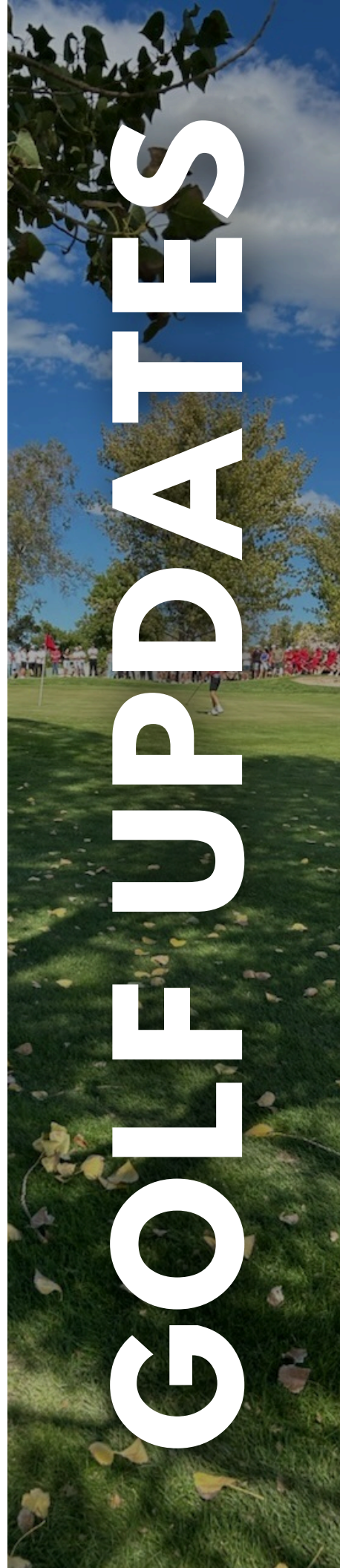
