Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

It's a sure sign of spring when the weed removal boat returns to the water, and that officially happened this past Monday. While we typically aim for an April 15 start date, this year's launch was delayed due to weather and limited staffing. We're happy to report that the boat is now up and running.

With the arrival of spring, we've also seen an increase in vandalism throughout the park. So far this year, there has been damage to the new playground at Woodland Park, the amphitheater, the tunnel, and nearly every restroom facility. Based on current information, much of this activity appears to involve local residents. We encourage parents to talk with their children about the impact of these actions, as they result in costly repairs and reduced services that affect the entire community.

We've also completed several improvements to the pool to help it operate more efficiently this season. At the same time, we are monitoring how the opening of the new Deseret Peak pool may affect attendance and revenue. It's important for residents to understand that our pool is aging and has exceeded its original life expectancy. While this year's work has extended its usability for a few more years, ongoing maintenance costs will continue to rise. Eventually, the community will need to decide whether maintaining a pool remains a priority and an investment residents are willing to support.

Looking ahead, we're excited to host a major new event at the end of the month. The organizer of the Stansbury Days car show, who has also managed a large car show in Salt Lake City, is bringing that event to Stansbury. The car show is scheduled for Monday, May 25. That same weekend, we are planning a pool opening celebration, which will include a nighttime swim and an outdoor movie. More details on both events will be shared in the coming weeks.

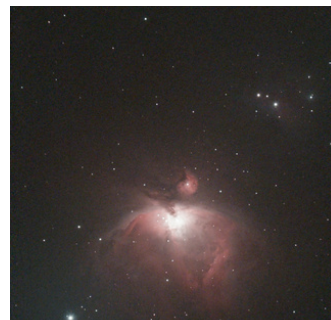

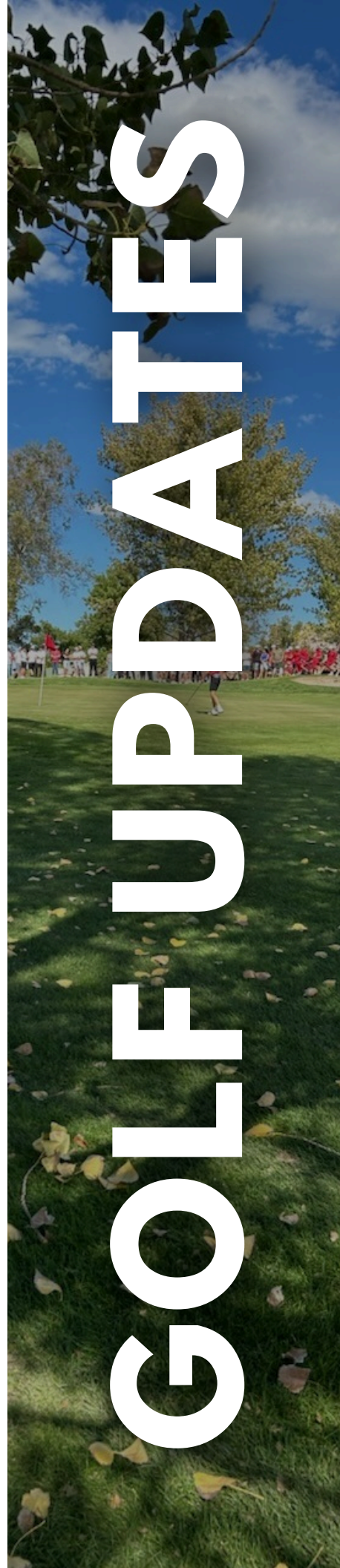

STANSBURY DAYS 2026

Stansbury Days 2026 will fall on August 13th-15th this year. Vendor Applications are now being accepted! We are currently looking for volunteers to help coordinate the volunteer effort, lead the vendor show, paddleboard races, lighted boat parade and host a corn hole tournament! Millpond Park:

The first phase of Millpond Park is nearing completion, including the parking lot, a section of the UDOT trail, parking lot lighting, restroom power, amphitheater wiring, and irrigation. A few materials are still needed to finish the electrical infrastructure, but we anticipate this phase will be fully complete by mid-May 2026. The Agency is currently awaiting a decision on the UORG grant application, which would fund completion of the park and opening of the amphitheater. A decision is expected by June 2026.

Sound Wall Trail:

The Agency has been working closely with UDOT to finalize designs and address remaining details before taking this project out to bid. Careful attention is being given to the engineering plans to ensure a smooth construction process. This 10-foot-wide shared-use asphalt trail is expected to go out to bid by the end of May 2026, with construction anticipated to be completed by the end of the year.

Oscarson Park:

The Agency has awarded Blu Line Designs the contract for the comprehensive design and development of Oscarson Park. A kickoff meeting was held at the end of April 2026, marking the beginning of efforts to bring this long-awaited park to life. Community input will play an important role in shaping the park's amenities, so residents are encouraged to watch for upcoming outreach opportunities and announcements. The goal is to have final engineering plans completed by the end of 2026, with the first phase of construction beginning in spring 2027.
