Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

I've been getting a lot of questions about the parking lot at Millpond Park and the decision to build it when we did. To understand that decision, it's important to understand how we are funded.

We have three funds. The first is the General Fund, which is used for daily operations and is unrestricted, meaning funds can be reallocated throughout the year based on operational needs and changes. A subset of that fund is the Capital Project Fund, which is reserved and requires specific reprogramming steps to increase funding during a budget year. If less is spent, those funds remain available for future budget cycles. The third is the Impact Fee Fund, which is restricted and can only be used on certain identified projects.

In the 2019 plan, there were four approved projects for Impact Fee funding: the Shoreline Project, supported by a UORG grant; the Soundwall Trail Project, supported by a UDOT grant; the Millpond Park Project; and the Oscarson Park Project. Of those, Millpond Park was the most shovel-ready, so the board decided to move forward with that project first.

The first phase was the parking lot, which was designed not only to support events at the amphitheater but also to improve safety by moving cars off that stretch of road during the winter, when the area sees heavy use. The project also connects to the Soundwall Trail and will eventually tie into another planned trail running from the Millpond parking lot to the golf course and clubhouse parking lot, and eventually to the park-and-ride lot across Pole Canyon Road. In addition, restroom facilities were included to help protect the spring behind the amphitheater from contamination by human waste.

No one is happy with the decision to originally place the amphitheater where it is, especially after the townhomes above it were allowed to be built. However, the structure could not be moved, leaving us with the choice of either tearing it down, allowing it to become a hazard and an eyesore, or developing the park around it. Because there has been interest from individuals and groups in using the facility, it seemed in the community's best interest to continue with the park development plans.

Regarding safety and park use, we are working with the Tooele County Sheriff's Office to implement new restrictions on e-bikes and other motorized vehicles in the parks. This has become a significant safety concern and needs to be addressed.

We also ask residents to respect the golf course, both for their own safety and as a courtesy to those using the course. It is a golf course, not a public park, even though the surrounding green spaces may suggest otherwise. The ponds are intended as water hazards and part of the overall water management system, not fishing ponds. People using the course for those activities are not welcome, nor is the course an appropriate place for family or wedding photos.

It is an active golf course, and being struck by a golf ball traveling 60 miles per hour can be dangerous. Please stay off the course unless you are actively golfing.

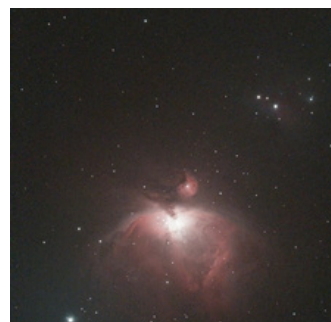

1. Millpond Park: The first phase is complete (parking lot, section of the UDOT trail, parking lot lights, restroom power, wiring to the amphitheater, and irrigation)! The Agency was recently awarded a \$200,000 UORG grant to help complete the remaining work on Millpond Park, specifically to open the amphitheater as a functional outdoor venue. The Agency anticipates advertising this second phase of development for bidding by mid-Summer 2026.
2. Sound Wall Trail: The Sound Wall Trail has been long-awaited and is in the final stages of engineering development. The Agency anticipates advertising this project for bidding in early June and completing the trail by the end of this year. This non-motorized, shared-use asphalt trail will extend from Village Boulevard to Millpond Park to support local pedestrian transit.
3. Oscarson Park: As of May 28th, there were 211 responses from the community voicing their preferences for amenities for Oscarson Park. The Agency sent out a QR code to homes immediately near the park, as well as on the Facebook page & the monthly bulletin, so anyone could cast their vote. These responses have been logged and are currently being entered into the relevant data to begin creating preliminary designs that will be shown to the public for further community discussion. The Agency expects to present 3 design choices at a future Board Meeting, based on community responses and the popularity of the amenities. The community will also be made aware of the anticipated total construction costs for these amenities when the design choices are presented.

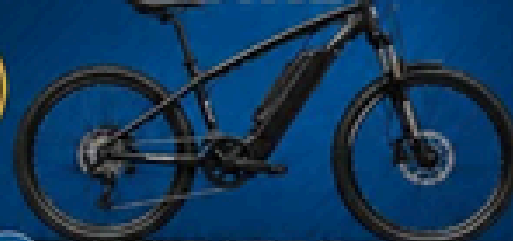
