Message From the GM, James Hanzelka

As we move deeper into the summer, I'd like to remind everyone just how dry conditions are this year. We've already responded to two fire-related incidents around the clubhouse, and many areas throughout the community are especially vulnerable to rapid fire spread. As we approach the upcoming holidays, we ask everyone to be mindful of the risks associated with private fireworks and to follow all local safety guidelines. Our Stansbury Days fireworks show will not be affected, as it is conducted by licensed professionals. We did explore replacing the fireworks with a drone show, but unfortunately the cost was prohibitive. I've also received several questions about the entrance fountains. They are currently not operating due to electrical issues that we believe may have been caused by the road construction along SR 36. Our team is working to locate the source of the problem so we can restore service as soon as possible. At the same time, we've been making improvements to the irrigation systems at both entrances and continuing restoration work around the clubhouse following the installation of the new pool backflush line.

This spring, we invested significant time and effort into improving the pool and its operations. While there is still work ahead to do because the pool is an older facility that naturally requires ongoing maintenance, we've already received positive feedback on many of the completed improvements. Although attendance is understandably down somewhat this year with the opening of the County's new pool, the Board remains committed to providing this valuable amenity for Stansbury Park residents.

We're also excited to once again partner with the Stansbury Strong Coalition for this year's Stansbury Days celebration. The coalition has taken on the task of helping coordinate volunteers for the event. We are especially grateful to the Harris family for their tremendous efforts in securing sponsorships that help offset event costs. We also have many dedicated volunteers already committed, but there is always room for more helping hands, as Stansbury Days is a large community event with many moving parts.

On behalf of the Board and staff, we wish you and your family a safe, enjoyable Fourth of July and Pioneer Day holiday. Thank you for being part of our community, and we look forward to a wonderful remainder of the summer.

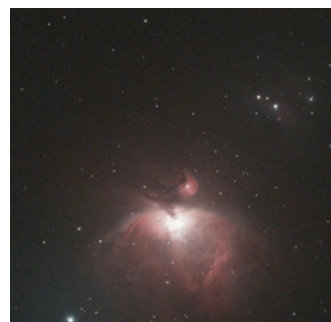

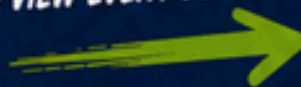

- ALL E-BIKE AND E-SCOOTER RIDERS UNDER 21 MUST WEAR **CPSC HELMETS** ON ROADS
- ALL E-MOTORCYCLE RIDERS UNDER 21 MUST WEAR **DOT-APPROVED HELMETS**

 - ✓ INSURANCE
