The one negative aspect of the event was that the fireworks went off much earlier than planned. Lantis Fireworks has taken responsibility for the mistake and credited us for the second payment.

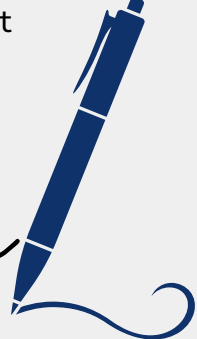
