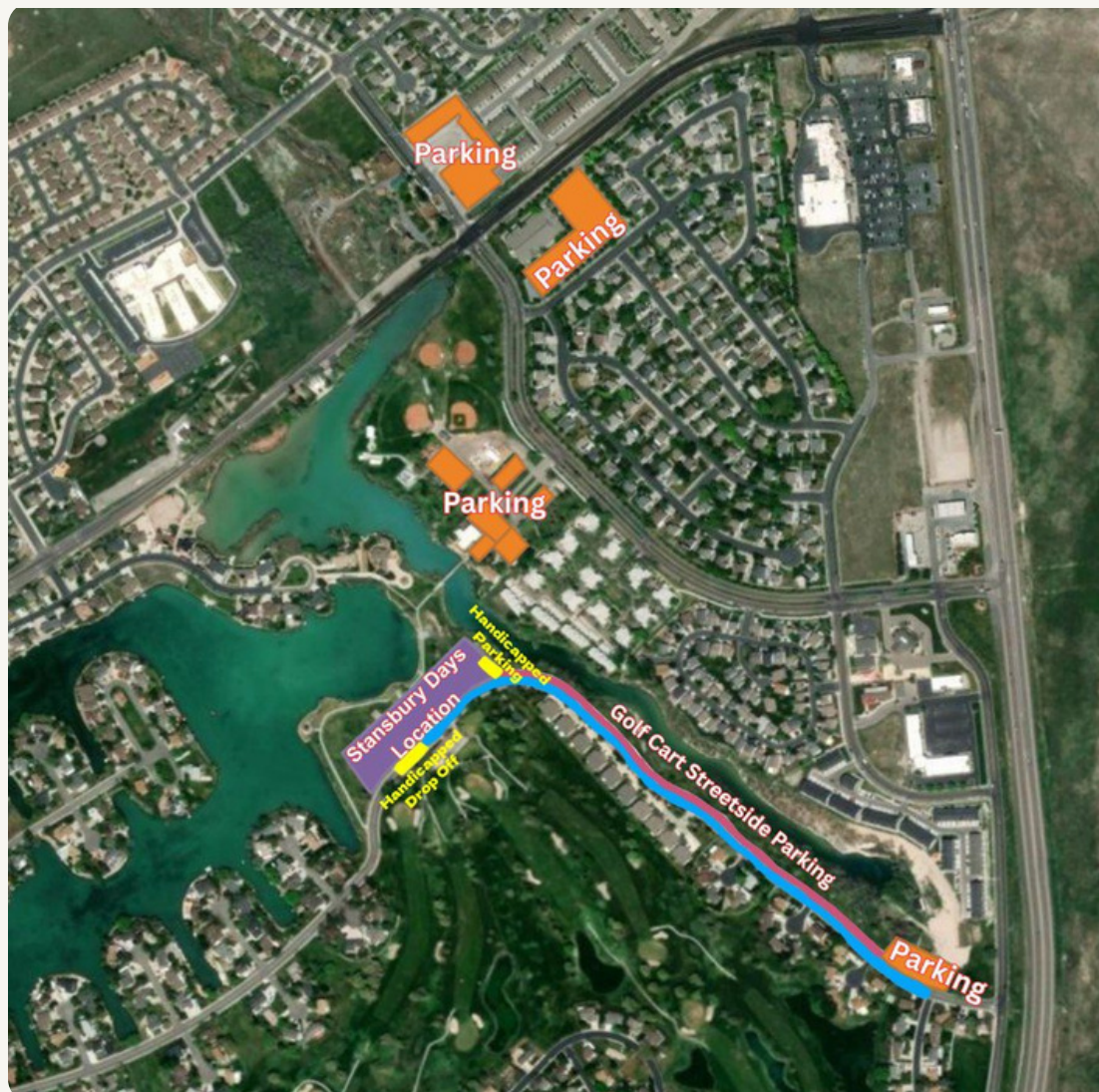

CLUBHOUSE DRIVE

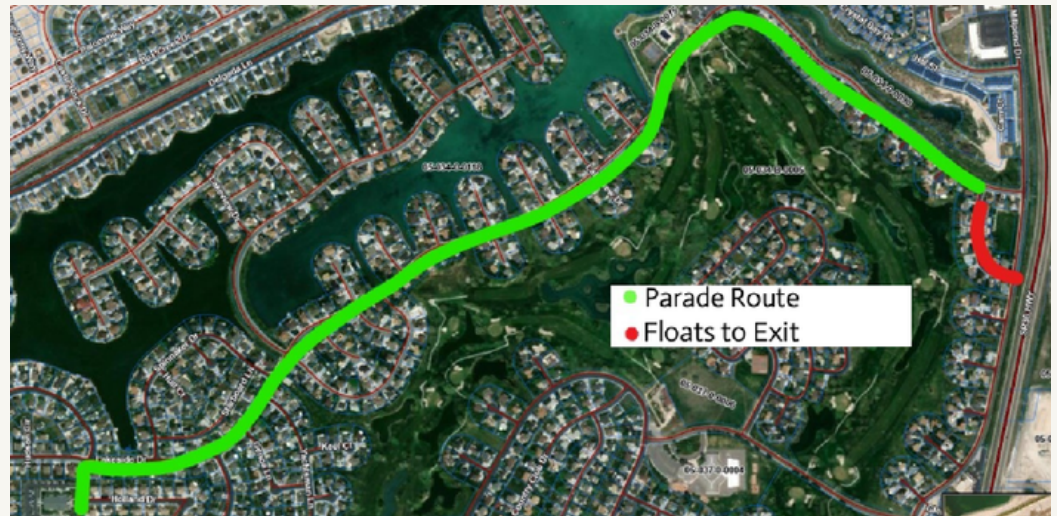
The blue route is closed to general traffic. Golf-cart streetside parking is marked in pink.

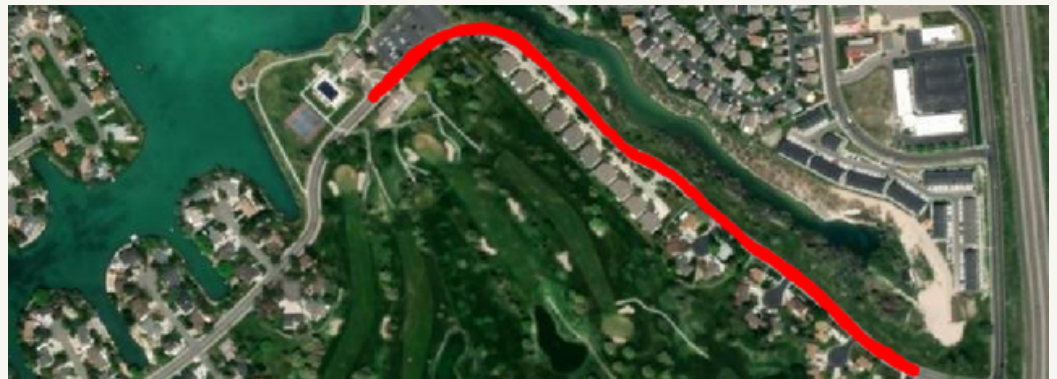

ROAD CLOSED FROM THE CLUBHOUSE TO MILLPOND DRIVE

Plan an alternate route and allow extra travel time.

THROUGH TRAFFIC

7:00 AM-4:00 PM

Road closed to through traffic.

ALL TRAFFIC

10:00-11:00 AM

Closed to all traffic for the parade.

The parade begins at 10:00 AM sharp. Follow posted detours and volunteer directions.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

A LITTLE PLANNING HELPS



Come prepared for outdoor community events near roads, parks and water.



CHECK FOR UPDATES

Review the Stansbury Days webpage before leaving home.



PLAN YOUR PARKING

Use designated parking and keep driveways and mailboxes clear.



PREPARE FOR HEAT

Bring water, sunscreen, hats and weather-appropriate clothing.



WATER SAFETY

Supervise children closely near the lake, pool, bridge and boat-race areas.



FOLLOW EVENT ROUTES

Do not enter closed roads, setup areas or emergency lanes.



BRING WHAT YOU NEED

Portable chairs or blankets may be helpful for outdoor activities.



KEEP PARKS CLEAN

Use event trash containers and take personal items when leaving.
